It is a place to sell and purchase new and serviceable used equipment and that is outgrown or little used. Sorry, no three pin binding systems, or downhill equipment will be accepted.

What could be on sale?

Cross country skis for kids and adults, boots, poles, bindings, snowshoes, roller skis and blades, car racks and ski boxes.

I have a pair of skis in the basement- what's next?

All potential merchandise needs to be in good shape. Equipment drop off is Thursday from 1 pm - 7 pm, Friday 8:30 am - 5:00 pm, Saturday from 8:30 am - 5:00 pm or Sunday 8 to 9:30 am. You set a reasonable price by clearly labeling each item with name, phone, email address and a whole dollar cost. An Equipment Swap Form will also need to be completed. This can be filled out before arriving by sending us an email request at paul.kuznia@oprhp.state.ny.us

A \$1.00 service charge will be collected for each item dropped off to cover cost of running the event. If sold, 20% of the sale price is retained by the Friends of Fahnestock & Hudson Highlands to be used for improving FWP programs. Unsold items need to be picked up between 3-4 pm. Any unclaimed goods will become the property of the Fahnestock Winter Park. If your item sells, within ten days a check, less 20% of sale price, will be mailed to your home

Admission is free. Displayed prices are nonnegotiable and sales are final. Small denomination bills or checks accepted. No credit cards accepted for consignment items.
