

### Transient Marina Slip Reservation Information

- Applications will be accepted beginning April 1 each year, and reservations will be approved on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Slips may be reserved with a maximum continuous stay of 14 nights from May 1 through mid-October. Maximum total stay from May 1 through Labor Day weekend is 30 nights.
- Full payment must be made at the time of the application and received no later than 2 days prior to the reservation period. Make checks payable to NYSOPRHP and return completed application and a self-addressed stamped envelope to: Taughannock Falls State Park

- Cancellations will be accepted 24 hours prior to the scheduled arrival. The \$9.00 advance reservation fee is non-refundable. A \$9.00 cancellation fee will be charged to refunds.

### Marina Policies and Procedures

1. Boat trailer storage will be available in designated areas only.
2. The region reserves the right to assign or re-assign slips in order to efficiently utilize all available slips.
3. All Park rules and regulations as well as applicable State and Federal rules and regulations will be observed. Parks reserves the right to terminate, without prior notice or refund, any permit issued when rules and regulations are violated.
4. The Permittee assumes all risks related to this permit and shall be solely responsible and answerable in damages for all accidents or injuries to persons or property, and hereby covenants and agrees to indemnify and keep harmless the People of the State of New York; Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation; their officers and employees; from any and all claims, whether direct or indirect, arising out of the operation of this Permit, or the carelessness, negligence or improper conduct of the Permittee or any servant, agent or employee thereof.
5. The Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation shall not be responsible for property damage or personal injury to the Permittee, or any person upon the premises at the invitation of the Permittee.
6. Pet owners must be able to show certificate proof of their pets' current rabies inoculation for pets on board. All pets are to be on a 6-foot maximum leash at all times.
