

MARINA SEASONAL SLIP INFORMATION

Seasonal marina slips are available at the Taughannock Falls State Park. An application is required annually. Applications with full payment must be postmarked or hand delivered to the park office from the first business day after January 1 to January 15.

Drawings will be held on or before January 30, and applicants will be notified of results. Successful applicants are guaranteed annual renewals for up to five years. Rental rates will be established annually. In the event that all slips of one size are filled at the time of the lottery, the applications will be placed on a waiting list. Applications postmarked after January 15th will be added to the waiting list on a first-come, first-serve basis. Be sure to include copy of boat registration showing over-all length of boat. The length of boats is limited to maximum of 24'. No electric is available. Height of boat cannot be more than 6 feet above water line due to bridge at entrance to marina.

FEES: For boats 18' and under, the seasonal slip rate is \$625.00 for non-electrical service. For boats over 18' the fee is \$42.00 per foot. For credit card payments please contact the park office during normal business hours Monday – Friday, prior to the January 15th deadlines.

Complete and mail application with a check made payable to "NYSOPRHP", a copy of boat registration, a copy of current rabies certificate if applicable and stamped, self-addressed envelope to: Taughannock Falls State Park, 2221 Taughannock Park Road, Trumansburg, NY 14886.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. One marina vehicle pass will be issued to permit entrance to the park where the slip is located without payment of the vehicle use charge. Use of facilities at other parks requires payment of appropriate fee at the park.
2. Boat trailer storage space is not available at Allan H. Treman State Marine Park, Taughannock Falls State Park or Lodi Point State Marine Park. Off-season storage of boats is not available.
3. The region reserves the right to assign or re-assign slips in order to efficiently utilize all available slips.
4. In the event a boat is sold, Permittee will notify park and park will transfer slip to new owner. Any other assignment, subletting, or transferring, directly or indirectly, by the Permittee is prohibited. Any and all rights and privileges granted by this permit are for the sole use of the Permittee.
5. All boats must be removed from the marina by the fourth Monday in October. Per night fee may be assessed for late removals.
6. Slips shall be kept neat and orderly. Runways and boardwalks must be kept clear at all times. Rowboats, dinghies, and other accessory equipment must be kept within the confines of the assigned slip. Carpeting, tires, fire hoses, TV antennas, bicycles etc., are not to be attached to the piers, catwalks or piles. Painting, stripping of paint, hanging clothes and laundry are prohibited. Heads (toilets) shall be dumped in designated on-shore dumping stations only.
7. Open fires will not be allowed in the marina basin. Any condition aboard or around the boat that is deemed a fire hazard, in the opinion of the Park Manager, shall be removed immediately.
8. All Park rules and regulations as well as applicable State and Federal rules and regulations will be observed. When rules and regulations relating to public safety have been violated, the Region reserves the right to reject any application for a slip, and to terminate without prior notice or refund, any permit issued. Amplification of music or other sound is not permitted.
9. Marina users shall respect the rights and privacy of others and maintain quiet hours from 10:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m.
10. Water and electrical accessories must be approved by the Park Manager. Water may not be available during early and/or late season. Modification of park electric equipment and supply is prohibited.
11. The Permittee assumes all risks related to this permit and shall be solely responsible and answerable in damages for all accidents or injuries to person or property, and hereby covenants and agrees to indemnify and keep harmless the People of the State of New York; the Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation; their officers and employees; from any and all claims, suits, losses, damage or injury to person or property of whatsoever kind or nature, whether direct or indirect, arising out of the operation of this Permit, or the carelessness, negligence or improper conduct of the Permittee or any servant, agent or employee thereof.
12. The Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation shall not be responsible for property damage or personal injury to the Permittee, or any person upon the premises at the invitation of the Permittee.
13. Pet owners must provide copy of a current rabies inoculation for pets on board. All pets are to be on a 6-foot maximum leash at all times.
14. Special permits are required for commercial activities.

REFUND POLICY FOR SEASONAL MARINA SLIP RENTALS

For cancellation before May 15th – 100% refund credit. For cancellation before June 15th – 50% refund credit. For cancellation before July 15 – 25% refund credit. No credit after July 15th. A refund processing fee of \$9.00 will be deducted from the revenue credit
