TAUGHANNOCK FALLS STATE PARK Tent Information and Permit

Terms and Conditions

1. Allowed only with rental of a shelter
2. Park managers will designate the area where tent is to be erected. Person putting up tent must first check with park office.
3. An alcoholic beverage permit will be required if alcoholic beverages are to be served or available.
4. Limited amplification of music may be aloud with prior approval.
5. The Permittee assumes all risks related to this permit and shall be solely responsible and answerable in damages for all accidents or injuries to person or property, and hereby covenants and agrees to indemnify and keep harmless the People of the State of New York; the Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation; their officers and employees; from any and all claims, suits, losses, damage or injury to person or property of whatsoever kind of nature, whether direct or indirect, arising out of the operation of this Permit, or the carelessness, negligence or improper conduct of the Permittee or any servant, agent or employee thereof.
6. The Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation shall not be responsible for property damage of personal injury to the Permittee, or any person upon the premises at the invitation of the Permittee.
7. The Permittee shall leave the premises in a neat and sightly condition and shall reimburse the Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation for any damage caused by the Permittee, or any person on the premises at the invitation of the Permittee. All trash/garbage is carry-in, carry-out.
8. The Permittee shall abide by all Park rules and regulations as well as applicable State and Federal laws.
9. The Permittee hereby waives any and all claims for compensation for any and all loss or damage sustained by reason or any interference by any public agency or official in the operation of this Permit; any such interference shall not relieve the Permittee from any obligations hereunder.
10. Tents must be erected and dismantled the day of the event and any picnic tables moved to original locations or other approved by park manager.
11. Neither Permittee or Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation agreement when such a failure is due to fire, flood, strikes or similar labor disturbances, war, riot, and insurrection. Events affected by public safety and health and/or causes beyond the control of the parties.
12. **FEES: The regular vehicular use fee is collected at the park entrance.**
