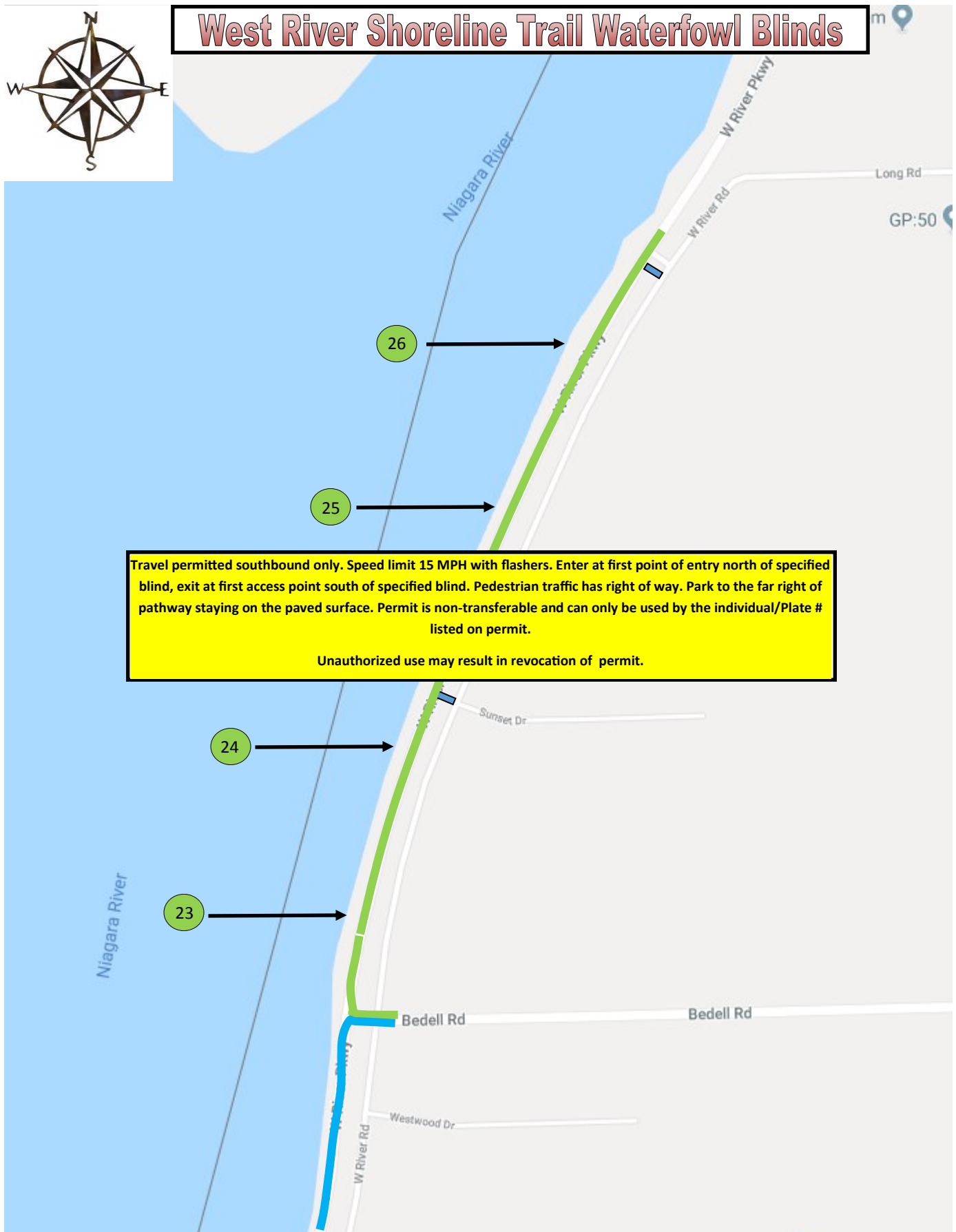

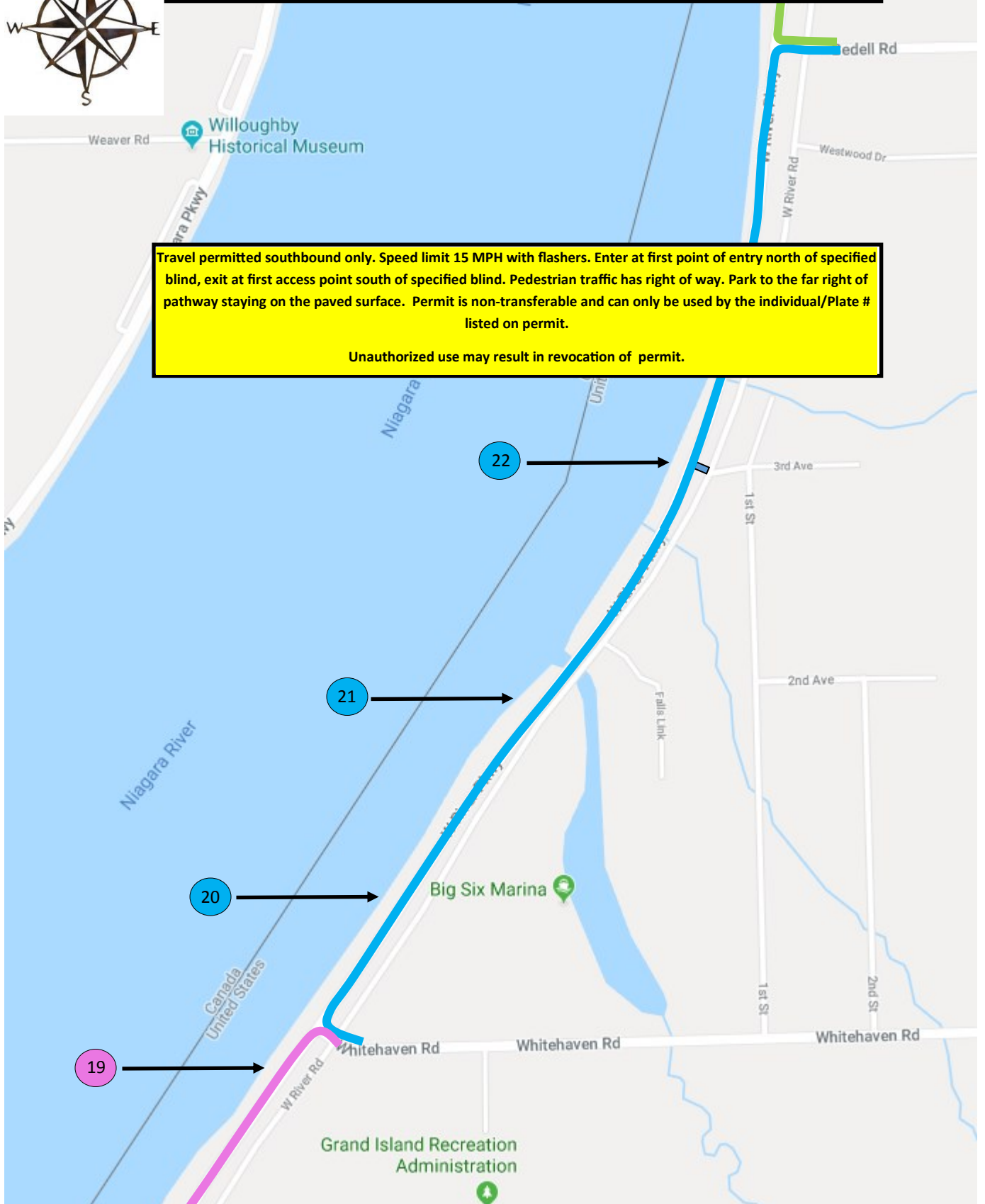

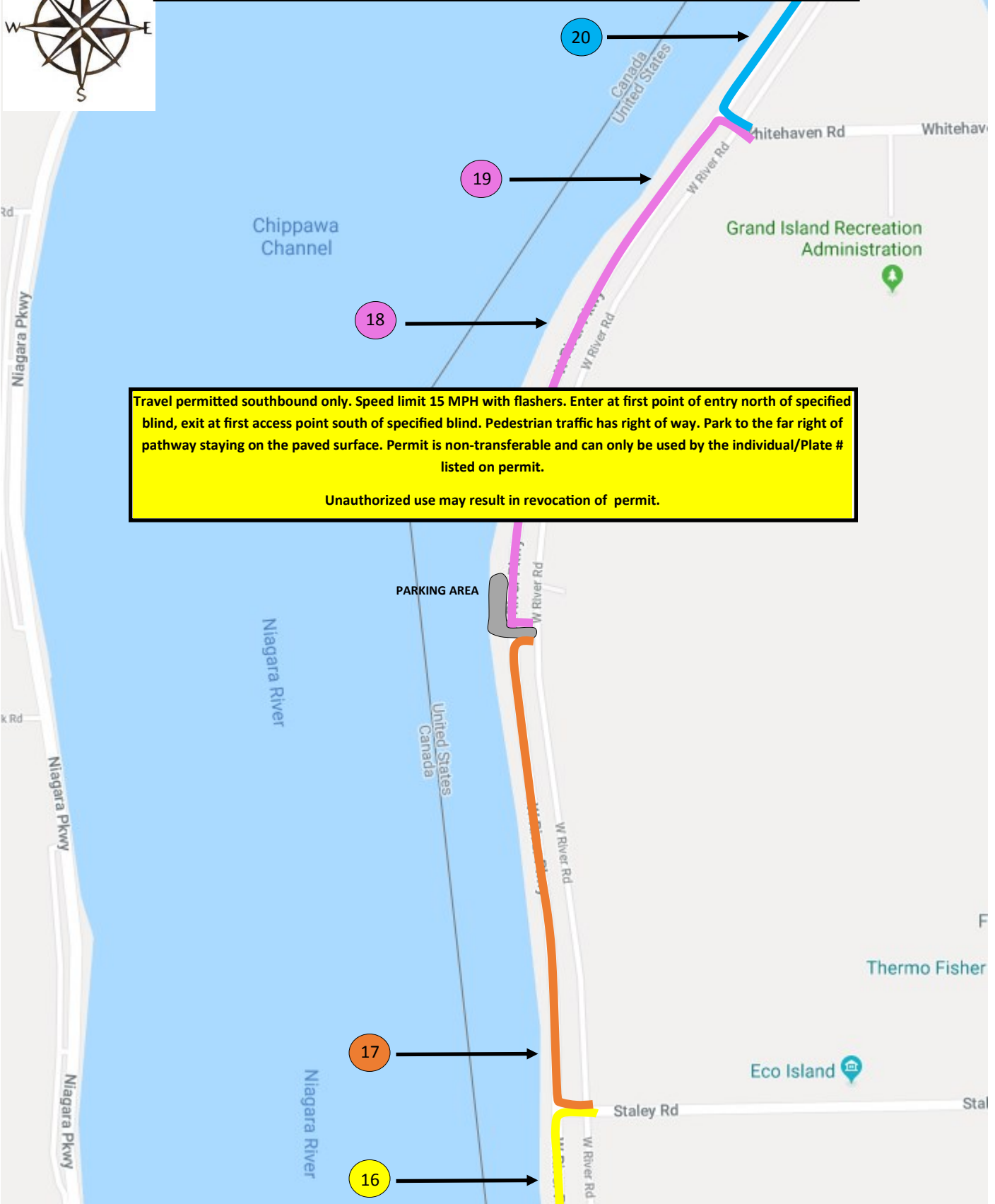

Unauthorized use may result in revocation of permit.



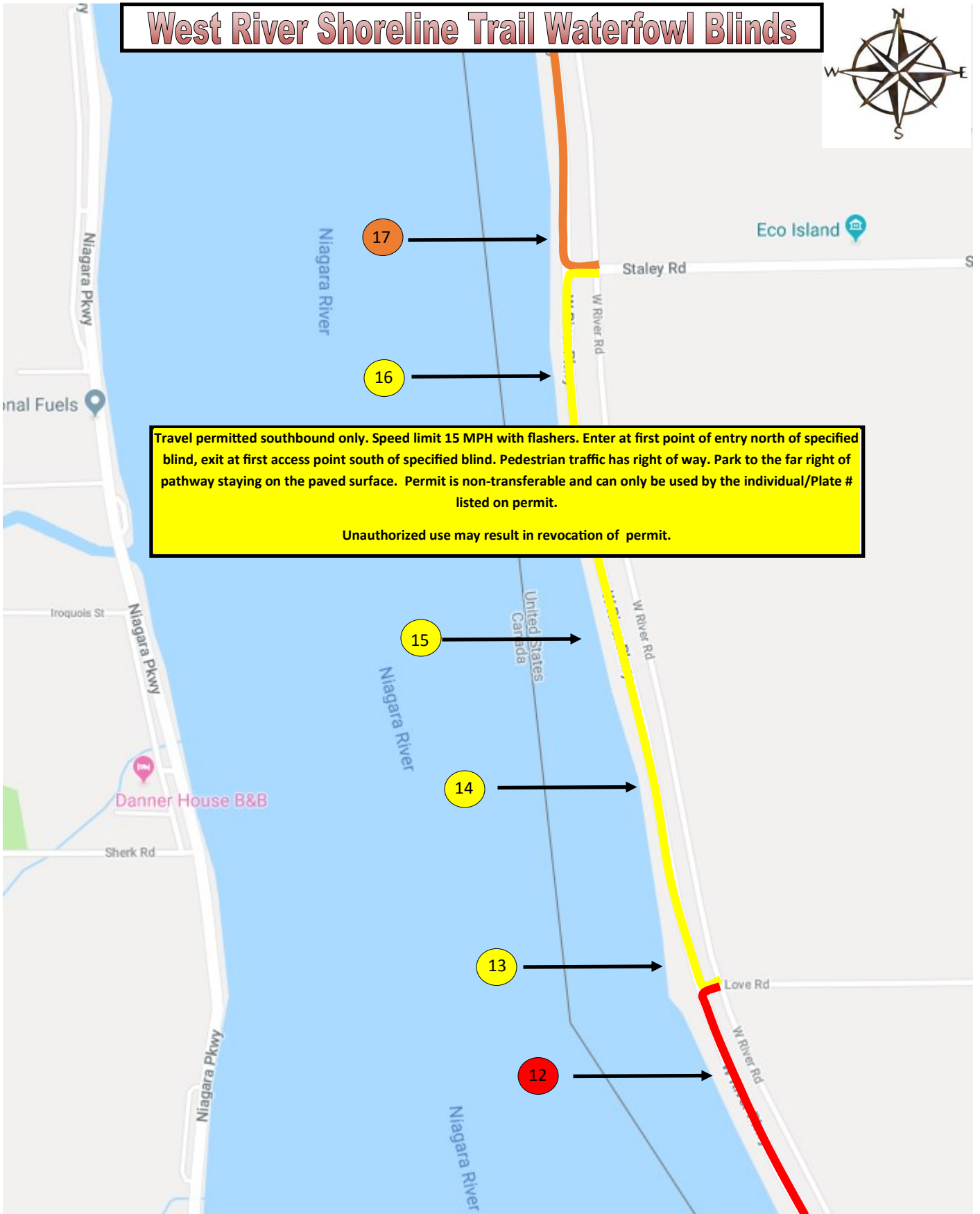

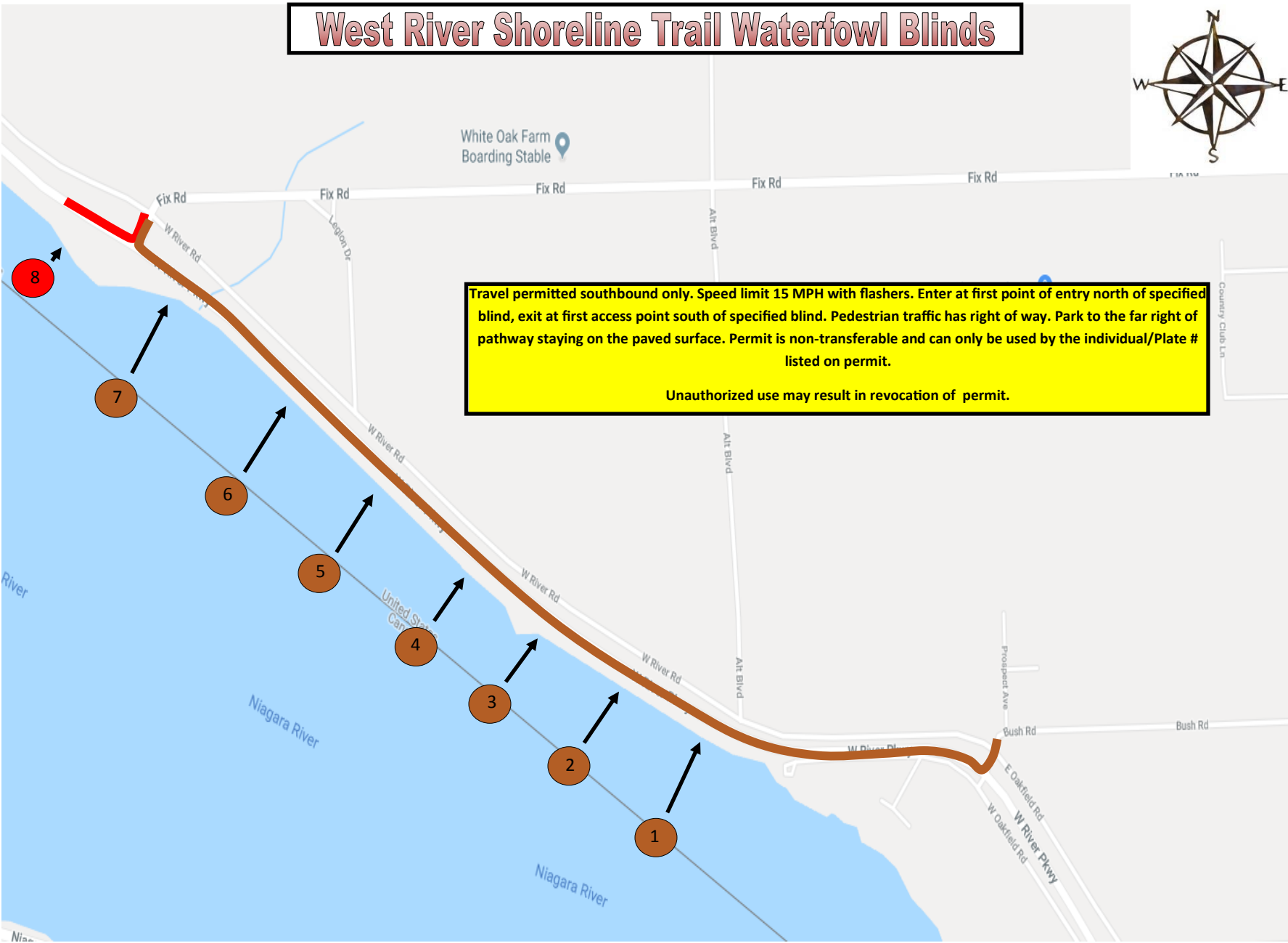
