Applications for a 2025 Indigenous Artisan Permit are due **NO LATER THAN** Tuesday, March 25th, 2025. The drawing will be held on Friday, March 28th, 2025, at 4:30pm at Niagara Falls State Park in the Community Room at the Education Center, 316 Prospect St., Niagara Falls, NY 14303.

APPLICANT MUST BE PRESENT FOR DRAWING

Each applicant **MUST** submit proof of Indigenous/Native American/First Nations status or heritage and PHOTO ID with the completed permit application. Failure to comply will result in disqualification of the applicant. Applicants must be 18 years or older to be eligible. Any disputes regarding eligibility must be presented in writing, to the Niagara Falls State Park permit office within 1 (one) week of permit drawing. Disputes will be resolved in communication with respective tribal nation leaders.

Items sold are to be traditional Indigenous handmade crafts. NO EXCEPTIONS

Six (6) names will be drawn. Each of the 6 winners may select a second seller who will be named on their permit. Second sellers must also provide proof of Native American status or heritage and photo ID to qualify.

PLEASE NOTE: Anyone who is chosen to receive a permit, or their 2nd seller, MUST SET UP AND USE THE PERMIT or another name will be selected. Non-use of the permit will result in forfeiture of that year's permit.

The permit will be valid from April 1st, 2025 through March 31st, 2026
