



PARK USE APPLICATION INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Permits that require commercial general liability insurance should include all the following provisions:

1. The Permittee agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the State of New York, OPRHP, and their officers, employees, and agents from and against any claims, damages, losses, and expenses arising out of or relating to this permit.
2. Original insurance certificate in the amount of \$2,000,000.00. The minimum general liability coverage is \$1 million per occurrence and \$2 million in the aggregate.
3. As additional insured, the following statement must be added to the policy:

"The State of New York, OPRHP, and their officers, employees and agents are included as additional insureds."
4. The Certificate Holder should read:

5. The permittee shall provide OPRHP with proof of commercial general liability insurance in the form of an ACORD 25 Certificate of Insurance. The original insurance certificate should be included with your application for a Permit.
